## LARGE BREEDS



### Plymouth Rock

Pair \$120, Trio \$200

- Light-barred
- A large utility breed, very docile with brown eggs

Some say this is one of the finest American dual-purpose breeds for meat and eggs. It originated as a cross between Black Cochins and the Dominique, and arrived in Australia in about the 1890. It has been a favourite with breeders ever since.



### Brahma

Pair \$120, Trio \$200

- White – very rare
- Show quality

A gentle but hardy heavy soft-feathered breed who love to forage. Originally called Brahma-Pootras after the river which divides China & India, the hens lay tinted brown eggs and make great mothers.



### Croad Langshan

Pair \$120, Trio \$200

- Large birds
- Top progeny

A huge and gentle bird - hens lay up to 200 big eggs a year. Originally from the Langshan district on the Yangtse River in China, they were first brought to the west in the 1870's by Major F.T. Croad.



### Australian Game

Pair \$130, Trio \$220

- They're ugly but we love 'em.
- Originally known as 'Colonial Game'
- Australia's first official breed was originally developed from Malay Game and several English game breeds
- A surprisingly docile and friendly breed



### White Silkies

Pair \$50, Trio \$70 - good type

### Coloured Silkies

Pair \$60, Trio \$80 - rare

- Ancient oriental breed
- Near black skin and unique plumage

Silkies are very reliable brooders for the eggs of other breeds. They require dry housing and regular cleaning due to their plumage and make wonderful pets.



## BANTAMS



### Araucanas

Pair \$60, Trio \$90

- From Morna's Sydney Royal winning line
- Blue / green eggs
- They are a tough breed – originated from the only tribe the Spanish could never conquer in South America
- Araucanas were crossed with lighter Mediterranean poultry and have been a recognized breed for over 400 years



### Rhode Island Reds

Pair \$60, Trio \$80

- A great starter bird for the backyard enthusiast
- The kids will enjoy them – they are easily handled
- Very calm and intelligent bird



### Gold-laced Wyandotte

Pair \$60, Trio \$80

- Dual purpose American breed for meat and eggs (brown)
- Wide variety of colour patterns
- Popular show bird
- Require regular care to maintain fertility

As you probably know, live animal transport is expensive. We do, however, strive to keep our transport charges as low as possible. The following are an indication of current shipping costs.

**Please remember to add this to the cost of your birds.**

All orders (including transport) must be paid in advance by credit card or cheque.

#### **By road**

It costs around \$99 to send a pair or trio of young birds to Sydney or Brisbane. Larger birds cost around \$140 for a trio. Regional areas are more expensive.

We now have reliable transport:

- between Sydney and Cairns on the east coast
- to northern and central western NSW
- to most of regional Queensland.

We can usually arrange delivery to **Southern NSW, Victoria and South Australia.**
